NOTICE – 2022 SPRING LOAD RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT AS OF MARCH 21, 2022 BY-LAW 2019-16

The Township enforces reduced load restrictions on trucks to protect the Township's roadways during spring thaw, when road damage is most likely to occur.

Reduced load limits are in effect where and when signs are posted depending on the road and weather conditions.

2022 INTERIM TAX BILLS

The 2022 Interim Tax Bills were mailed, with installment due dates of March 31, 2022 and May 31, 2022.

Payments can be made by **cash, cheque or online banking** (we do not accept credit/debit). For online banking your roll number, which can be found at the top of your Tax Bill is your 'account number'. (Note: most financial institutes require the full 19 digits, with no spaces, or decimals.

**** IMPORTANT** if you are paying your taxes on line and have **more than one piece of property** then PLEASE set up each piece of property with their own 'account' (roll number), so that the payment(s) get applied to the correct properties. **

SPRING GRADING

The Township of Chisholm has begun spring grading maintenance of our gravel road system and shall continue with grading when the weather and road conditions are favorable.

Please note the following:

- The Township prioritizes all maintenance by adherence to the minimum maintenance standards of Ontario (O.Reg 366/18), the severity of the required maintenance and the class of road by assessment of the annual average daily traffic and speed limit of the roadway;
- Grading shall only be performed when weather conditions and moisture content of the roadway are suitable;
- No heavy rain events can be forecasted in the next 24 hours - grading before heavy rains can result in the road condition deteriorating to a condition worse than before the grading was performed;
- Grading while conditions are wet and rainy may also contribute to silt in our waterways;
- We must allow the morning frost to come out of the top layer of the aggregate so that the equipment and operator can work efficiently.

We appreciate your patience and please use caution when travelling through the work zone of the grader.

BURN PERMITS 2022

Burn permits are usually required within the Township from April 1st to October 31st, but due to COVID19, the permits will **not** be issued **at this time**, but you **must** however follow the rules regarding burn time. No fires between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

The Township is planning on implementing a new method of issuing fire permits for the 2022 year. More information to follow.

Fire burning conditions/rules:

1. Do not permit more than four cubic meters of material to be burned at any one time.
2. Do not ignite any fire between 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. (including burn barrels).
3. A minimum of one person must be in constant attendance of the fire. Never leave fire unattended.
4. The permittee must have enough fire fighting equipment on hand to control the fire at all times (ie. Shovels, pales, axes, hose).
5. Permit only valid for burning of grass and wood or by-products of wood.
6. No burning in winds greater than 15 km/h.
7. Incinerator fires must be burned in an enclosed device covered by screen mesh with openings less than 5 millimeters. The incinerator must be at least 5 meters from any forest, at least 2 meters from flammable material, and must be monitored by a responsible person until the fire is out.

2022 DOG TAGS

According to By-law 2010-06, all dog owners must purchase a dog tag for each dog they possess on or before March 31st. **Dog license fees are as follows:**

		<u>After March 31st</u>
1 dog	\$10.00	\$30.00
2 dogs	\$25.00	\$45.00
3 dogs	\$50.00	\$70.00

Dog tags can also be purchased at the office or you can complete the attached form and mail it in along with payment made payable to the Township of Chisholm.

Please Note: Maximum three (3) dogs per household as per by-law 2010-06.
