

Did you know? Property Tax Edition

DYK that the property tax bills go out twice a year with 2 installments on each bill. The first bill is the Interim bill with due dates on March 31 and May 31. The final bill will go out in July with due dates on August 31 and October 31.

Why have I not received a property tax bill?

The Interim bill has gone out and everyone should have received it by know. There could be a couple of reasons why you didn't receive your bill:

- If you have a mortgage on your property and your taxes are paid through your mortgage holder, they directly receive your bill
- 2. If there are multiple owners on a property, the bill will only go to the one mailing address we have on file.

If you did not receive your bill for the above reasons, you can reach out to the office and be added to a list to get a duplicate copy.

How can I pay my property taxes?

You can pay the following ways:

- In person by cash, cheque and now debit (no credit).
- 2. Through your bank by setting up the township as a payee and paying as a bill using your entire roll number as your account number.
- 3. Drop off a cheque with the stub(s) from your tax bill into the secure drop box next to the main door.

How is the Interim tax bill calculated?

Because the current year budget is not passed by March 31st, the interim tax bill is calculated using 50% of the taxes paid in the prior year. If your property has a classification change, you will not see this change until the after the budget is passed and the Final bills go out.

NOTICE - 2023 SPRING LOAD RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT AS OF MARCH 18, 2023 BY-LAW 2019-16

The Township enforces reduced load restrictions on trucks to protect the Township's roadways during spring thaw, when road damage is most likely to occur.

Reduced load limits are in effect where and when signs are posted depending on the road and weather conditions.

SPRING GRADING

The Township of Chisholm will be doing spring grading maintenance of our gravel road system and shall continue with grading when the weather and road conditions are favorable.

Please note the following:

- The Township prioritizes all maintenance by adherence to the minimum maintenance standards of Ontario (O.Reg 366/18), the severity of the required maintenance and the class of road by assessment of the annual traffic and speed limit of the average daily roadway;
- Grading shall only be performed when weather conditions and moisture content of the roadway are suitable;
- No heavy rain events can be forecasted in the next 24 hours - grading before heavy rains can result in the road condition deteriorating to a condition worse than before the grading was performed;
- Grading while conditions are wet and rainy may also contribute to silt in our waterways;
- We must allow the morning frost to come out of the top layer of the aggregate so that the equipment and operator can work efficiently.

We appreciate your patience and please use caution when travelling through the work zone of the grader.
