STAY SAFE & KEEP WARM!

Cold winter weather is giving everyone's heating system a workout these days. The Chisholm Township Fire Department reminds you to beat the chill and stay safe this winter by:

- Ensuring woodstoves, fireplaces and fireplace inserts are installed by a qualified technician according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Having your heating system, vents and chimneys inspected and cleaned annually by a qualified technician.
- Ensuring outside heating vents are not blocked by snow.
- Letting ashes from your woodstove or fireplace cool before emptying them into a metal container with a tight-fitting lid, and storing the container outside.
- Using a fire screen in front of a fireplace.
- Burning dry, well-seasoned wood to reduce the risk of excessive creosote build-up in chimneys.
- Keeping space heaters at least one metre (three feet) away from anything that can burn, including curtains, upholstery and clothing.

2022 DOG TAGS

According to By-law 2010-06, all dog owners must purchase a dog tag for each dog they possess on or before March 31st. **Dog License fees are as follows:**

		<u>After March 31st</u>
1 dog	\$10.00	\$30.00
2 dogs	\$25.00	\$45.00
3 dogs	\$50.00	\$70.00

Dog tags can also be purchased at the office or you can complete the attached form and mail it in along with payment made payable to the Township of Chisholm.

Please Note: Maximum three (3) dogs per household as per by-law 2010-06.
