2022 BUDGET

The 2022 Budget was passed at the June 14th, 2022
Council Meeting.

Highlights:

- The tax rate will remain the same as the last 2 years;
- MPAC held off on changing the property assessment values so most people will pay the same amount of tax as they did in 2021 and 2020;
 - Capital Projects include: Bridge Replacement on Pioneer Road, River Road improvements from Golf Course Road to Cedar Road, Replace Bridge deck on Beach Road Bridge, Public Works Garage expansion; and
 - Other projects: Road Needs Study Project, Asset management Software Implementation, Online Citizen Portal, Debit Services.

On June 15th, 2022 the General Government Committee met at 6:00 p.m. One of the agenda items was a memo from the CAO asking Council for direction on STR because there has been an increase in comments and concerns to the township office. 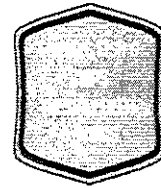
Toddler and younger children may attend our early hour program with their guardian: weekdays from 10:30 a.m. 11:15 am.
