2023 INTERIM TAX BILLS - REMINDER

The 2023 Interim Tax Bills were mailed out in February with two installment dates of March 31 and May 31, 2023.

Payment can be made by cash, cheque, online, or debit (**not credit**). If you pay online, your roll number would be your "account number" (most financial institutes require the full 19 digits, with no spaces, decimals etc.)

NOTICE – 2023 SPRING LOAD RESTRICTONS

With the roads still frozen, we **will not have to start half load restrictions as of March 1, 2023** as per By-law 2019-16. It is **estimated** that they will start March 17th. Please watch for the signs to go up at the entrances to the township or call the township office for more information.

WHAT COLOUR DO WE PAINT OUR NEW DUMP TRUCK?

The township is replacing one of the dump trucks and needs help deciding what colour to paint it. The Public Works employees had an idea to pick a paint colour that raises awareness for a cause that the township can support. For example, pink for Breast Cancer or orange for Every Child Matters. When this idea was presented to Council, they thought that the community should be involved in helping pick the colour and the cause to support.

Here are the rules:

- It can only be one solid colour for the truck (or at the most one colour for the cab and a different colour for the box)
- It has to support a cause to raise awareness
- Keep your submissions positive and relevant to our community
- Deadline to offer an idea is March 16, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.

The Public Works employees will review all the ideas and make their recommendation to Council.

Time to Change your Clocks and the Batteries in all Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms!

Clocks will spring forward one hour at 2:00 a.m. on **Sunday, March 12, 2023** and the Chisholm Township Fire Department urges you to install new batteries in smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when you change your clock. Smoke alarms provide the crucial early warning you need to survive a fire, but they'll only do that with working batteries. Check your alarms regularly, and install new batteries annually.

Ontario law requires working smoke alarms on every storey of the home and outside all sleeping areas. (For added protection, it is also a good idea to install smoke alarms inside bedrooms). If you have a fuel-burning appliance including a furnace or gas stove, fireplace, wood stove or an attached garage, you are also required to install a carbon monoxide alarm outside sleeping areas.

Tampering with or removing the batteries from smoke and carbon monoxide alarms is against the law. Penalties for failing to comply with the Fire Code range from a \$360.00 ticket to a \$50,000.00 fine.

According to By-law 2010-06, all dog owners must purchase a dog tag for each dog they possess on or before March 31st. **Dog License fees are as follows:**

		<u>After March 31st</u>
1 dog	\$10.00	\$30.00
2 dogs	\$25.00	\$45.00
3 dogs	\$50.00	\$70.00

Dog tags can also be purchased at the office or you can complete the attached form and mail it in along with payment made payable to the Township of Chisholm.

Please Note: Maximum three (3) dogs per household as per by-law 2010-06.
