NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

At its regular meeting held June 14, 2022, the Council of the Township of Chisholm adopted a resolution directing staff to prepare an application to the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing for specific amendments to its Official Plan. These amendments are intended to:

1. ensure compliance with section 16 (3) of the *Planning Act* which requires official plans to contain policies that authorize the use of additional residential units;
2. reduce restrictions on consent criteria in Rural zones; and
3. clarify wording and make minor corrections, as required.

Accordingly, the Township has prepared an initial draft of specific amendments to its Official Plan. Both the current Official Plan and the proposed amendments are available for your review on the Township's website at www.chisholm.ca. **A public meeting to receive public input will be held at 6:00 pm on September 27, 2022 at the Township Office. Interested parties are invited to attend in person or using ZOOM Meeting ID: 836 5238 6073 Passcode: 123456**

The proposed specific amendments are consistent with the planning principles outlined in the current Official Plan, namely to:

- protect the natural environment;
- encourage economic development;
- conserve natural resources;
- protect agricultural areas; and,
- protect the character of developed and undeveloped areas.

The proposed specific amendments to the Official Plan also take into account Ontario's Provincial Policy Statement, 2020 under the *Planning Act* and provincial strategies aimed at addressing housing availability and affordability challenges.

Council of the Township of Chisholm plans to initiate a review process of our official plan and zoning bylaw starting in 2023, as required by the *Planning Act*.

CAPITAL PROJECT UPDATE

The Projects planned for this summer did not go as planned for a number of reasons. Here is an update:

- Beach Road Bridge Deck will not be replaced this year as we are having more problems with the deck boards lifting on the South Shore Bridge. South Shore Bridge deck will be replaced this fall and Beach Road will be pushed to 2023.
- River Road project is delayed but will still be happening this year. Road Closures have been moved to Thursday Sept 1 and Friday Sept 2 between Golf Course and Cedar Road.
- Bridge replacement on Pioneer Road will be moved to 2023. The engineering is complete and the project will be tendered soon.
- The Public Works shop expansion is on track.
