# Give Chisholm's Firefighters a Brake!

In recent years Chisholm's firefighters have noticed more and more vehicles speeding past us when we are working on or beside the road or attending fires and accidents. Trafficrelated accidents are a major cause of firefighter injuries, so please slow down and make space for firefighters and fire vehicles when they are on their way to emergencies, entering or leaving private lanes and driveways, or stopped on the roadside. Please be extra careful when firefighters are working on or along roads.

When you see any emergency vehicle approaching with red lights flashing, the law requires you to slow down, signal and pull off to the right-hand side of the road.

When you see an emergency vehicle stopped on the road side, the law requires you to slow down and pass with caution, yielding the lane if you can do so safely.

When you are following an emergency vehicle responding to a call, the law requires you to leave a 150-metre buffer.

If you are charged with failing to do any of these things, you could face a fine ranging up to \$2,000.00, loss of three demerit points, or a two-year suspension of your driver's licence. Being careful around firefighters and fire trucks s not just about obeying the law and avoiding penalties, it is about keeping our community safe, and ensuring there is someone to answer the call when you need help.



#### 2023 DOG TAGS

According to By-law 2010-06, all dog owners must purchase a dog tag for each dog they possess on or before March 31st. **Dog License fees are as follows:** 

 After March 31st

 1 dog
 \$10.00
 \$30.00

 2 dogs
 \$25.00
 \$45.00

 3 dogs
 \$50.00
 \$70.00

Dog tags can also be purchased at the office or you can complete the attached form and mail it in along with payment made payable to the Township of Chisholm.

<u>Please Note:</u> Maximum three (3) dogs per household as per by-law 2010-06.
