Special Council Meeting February 8, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. In regards to Beach Road

Council will be deliberating on the ongoing discussion regarding the portion of Beach Road that is between Chiswick Line and Memorial Park Drive. This portion of Beach Road is a seasonally minimally maintained road mainly used for farming traffic. Due to environmental factors the current owners are requesting that Council upgrade and fully open this section of road to allow the property owners residential access off Beach Road. The factors that council will be discussing are:

- Ecological;
- 2. Financial;
- 3. Logistics; and
- 4. Legal advice.

STAY WARM SAFELY THIS WINTER

LANDFILL HOURS (winter hours)

Chisholm's Fire Department is urging everyone to keep fire safety in mind this winter.

"We often see more home fires during the winter months due to heating equipment and appliances," says Fire Chief Ray Ford. "People need to pay close attention to potential fire hazards such as fireplaces, furnaces, chimneys and vents, and space heaters."

There are some simple things people can do to stay fire safe during the colder months:

- Have fuel-burning appliances inspected annually by a registered contractor. Go to <u>COSafety.ca</u> to find a contractor near you.
- Keep chimneys and intake/exhaust vents for furnaces and heating appliances free of debris, ice and snow accumulations to reduce the risk of carbon monoxide (CO) build-up from inefficient combustion.
- Burn dry, well-seasoned wood in fireplaces and woodstoves to reduce excessive creosote build-up in chimneys.
- Allow ashes from your fireplace or woodstove to cool before emptying them into a metal container with a tight-fitting lid. Keep the container outside.
- Keep space heaters at least one metre (3 feet) away from anything that can burn, including curtains, upholstery and clothing.
- Replace worn or damaged electrical wires and connections on vehicles and extension cords and use the proper gauge extension cord for vehicle block heaters.
- Consider using approved timers for vehicle block heaters rather than leaving heaters on all night.
- Ensure that vehicles are not left running inside any garage or building.
- Ensure there is a working smoke alarm on every storey and outside all sleeping areas of your home.
- Install CO alarms to alert you to the presence of this deadly gas.

The Township's Fire Department reminds everyone that the Ontario Fire Code requires smoke alarms to be installed on every storey of your home and outside all sleeping areas. Carbon monoxide alarms are required outside all sleeping areas if the home has a fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage. For more information about smoke and carbon monoxide alarms, or fire safety, contact the Township office.

2024 INTERIM TAX BILLS - REMINDER

The 2024 Interim Tax Bills will be mailed out in February with two installment dates of March 28 and May 31, 2024.

Payment can be made by cash, cheque, online, or debit (not credit). If you pay online, your roll number would be your "account number" (most financial institutes require the full 19 digits, with no spaces, decimals etc.)
