CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE:

Memorial Park Drive (Alderdale to Kells) has been pulverized. Base repairs in two separate locations are complete.

Gravel is being applied to the following roads over the next week or so:

- Memorial Park Drive from Alderdale right through to Golf Course,
- Beach Road from Memorial Bayview/Islandview,
- Hills Siding from Alderdale to end of maintained portion,

Memorial Park Drive, on either side of the Beach Road Intersection, will be getting a bit of a lift with B Type 2 gravel to help with flooding mitigation.

Once all the gravel is dropped, calcium will be applied to those roads. All other gravel roads have their calcium.

Fire Department purchased a new Thermal Imager and some new bunker suits.

A new sea can has been delivered to the landfill. This sea can has a door on both ends and a wall will be put up to split it in half. One side will be used for the electronics drop off. This will keep things tidier and deter trespassing at the landfill. Next month we will advertise what is happening with the other side!
