- (c) A Nomination paper may be filed in person or by an agent.
- (d) After the Nomination paper is filed with the Clerk, it shall remain in the possession of the Clerk. If a greater number of candidates than required to fill the above offices are nominated, an election will be held.

Summer Student Job Posting



Emergency Preparedness Week May 1 – 7, 2022

How to be prepared for (almost) anything.

Canada's national Emergency Preparedness week is May 1-7. While you can't predict the next disaster or emergency, you can make events like last December's windstorm easier to cope with by having a plan and building an emergency kit.

Be prepared with these three steps:

- 1. Know the risks: What are the most likely hazards you face? A power outage? Being isolated by a road washout or snowstorm? A flood? Consider the risks, based on your location and what's happened in the past and add emergencies that could happen in our region, including windstorms and forest fires.
- 2. Plan ways to cope with the risks: If you had to leave, how would you get out? How would you alert members of your family or pick up your kids from school? How would you check in with neighbours, look after pets and livestock, and make sure your heating, water and electrical systems are safe?
- 3. Build an emergency kit: Most emergencies are short-term. If you can hunker down and get by, life usually returns to normal within 72 hours or less. That's why a kit should supply crucial needs for three days, including water, food, a phone and wind-up or battery-powered radio, first aid kit, important family documents, and other items including clothes, sleeping bags, etc.

2022 INTERIM TAX BILLS

The 2022 Interim Tax Bills were mailed, with installment due dates of March 31, 2022 and May 31, 2022.

Payments can be made by cash, cheque or online banking (we do not accept credit/debit). For online banking your roll number, which can be found at the top of your Tax Bill is your 'account number'. (Note: most financial institues require the full 19 digits, with no spaces, or decimals.

** IMPORTANT if you are paying your taxes on line and have more then one piece of property then PLEASE set up each piece of property with their own 'account' (roll number), so that the payment(s) get applied to the correct properties. **
