FIRE PREVENTION WEEK - OCTOBER 8 - 14, 2023

This Fire Prevention Week, Chisholm's Firefighters ask you to "stand by your pan"!

Cooking-related accidents are a major cause of household fires and injuries. To mark Fire Prevention Week, October 8-14, 2023, the Chisholm Township Fire Department offers these tips to make your Thanksgiving Day feast – and every meal – a safe and happy occasion.

- Stand by your pan: Turn pot handles towards the back of the stove, so hot food does not accidentally get knocked off the burners.
- Watch what you heat: Stay in the kitchen, especially when you are frying, grilling or broiling food. If you have to leave, turn off the stove. If you're baking or roasting in the oven, set a timer to help you remember to check it.
- Keep a one-metre "kid-free zone" around the stove and areas where hot food is being prepared and carried.

Remember to maintain working smoke alarms and have a plan to leave your home if a fire breaks out. Installing and testing smoke and carbon monoxide alarms is the single most important thing you can do to safeguard loved ones from fires and dangerous fumes.
