NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council for the Township of Chisholm will hold a public meeting on the 12th day of August, 2025, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. from the Council Chambers, to consider, and if approved, pass and enact at the following meeting a proposed By-Law to close, stop up, and declare the lands to be surplus, and to sell to the adjoining land owners, the portion of the following unopened road allowances, namely:

ALL AND SINGULAR THAT certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situated, lying and being in the Township of Chisholm, in the District of Nipissing, being part of an original lakeshore road allowance in front of Lot 16, Concession 13, in the said Township of Chisholm as shown on Plan 36R15308 and designated thereon as Part 1.

The said plan of survey may be examined at the Township Office, 2847 Chiswick Line, Chisholm Township, Ontario.

Council will, at the said meeting, hear from any person, or from their counsel, solicitor or agent, who claims his/her land to be prejudicially affected by the said By-Laws, and who applies to be heard at said meeting to the Municipal Council in advance of 3:00 p.m. on the scheduled date of the meeting.
