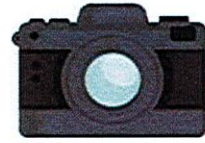

2026 Municipal and School Board Elections

Election Day for the Municipal and School Board Elections is **Monday, October 26, 2026**.

The Township of Chisholm will offer both **in-person voting** and **mail-in voting** for this election. Individuals wishing to run for office may file nomination papers until **Friday, August 21, 2026, at 2:00 p.m.**

To vote in a municipal election, you must be:

- A Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age;
- A resident of the municipality, or a property owner or tenant in the municipality, or the spouse of an owner or tenant; and
- Not otherwise prohibited from voting.

To be a candidate for municipal office, you must be:

- A Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age;
- A resident of the municipality, a non-resident owner or tenant of land in the municipality, or the spouse of such an owner or tenant;
- Not legally prohibited from voting; and
- Not disqualified by any legislation from holding municipal office.

Nomination fees are **\$100 for Council positions** and **\$200 for Head of Council (Mayor)**.

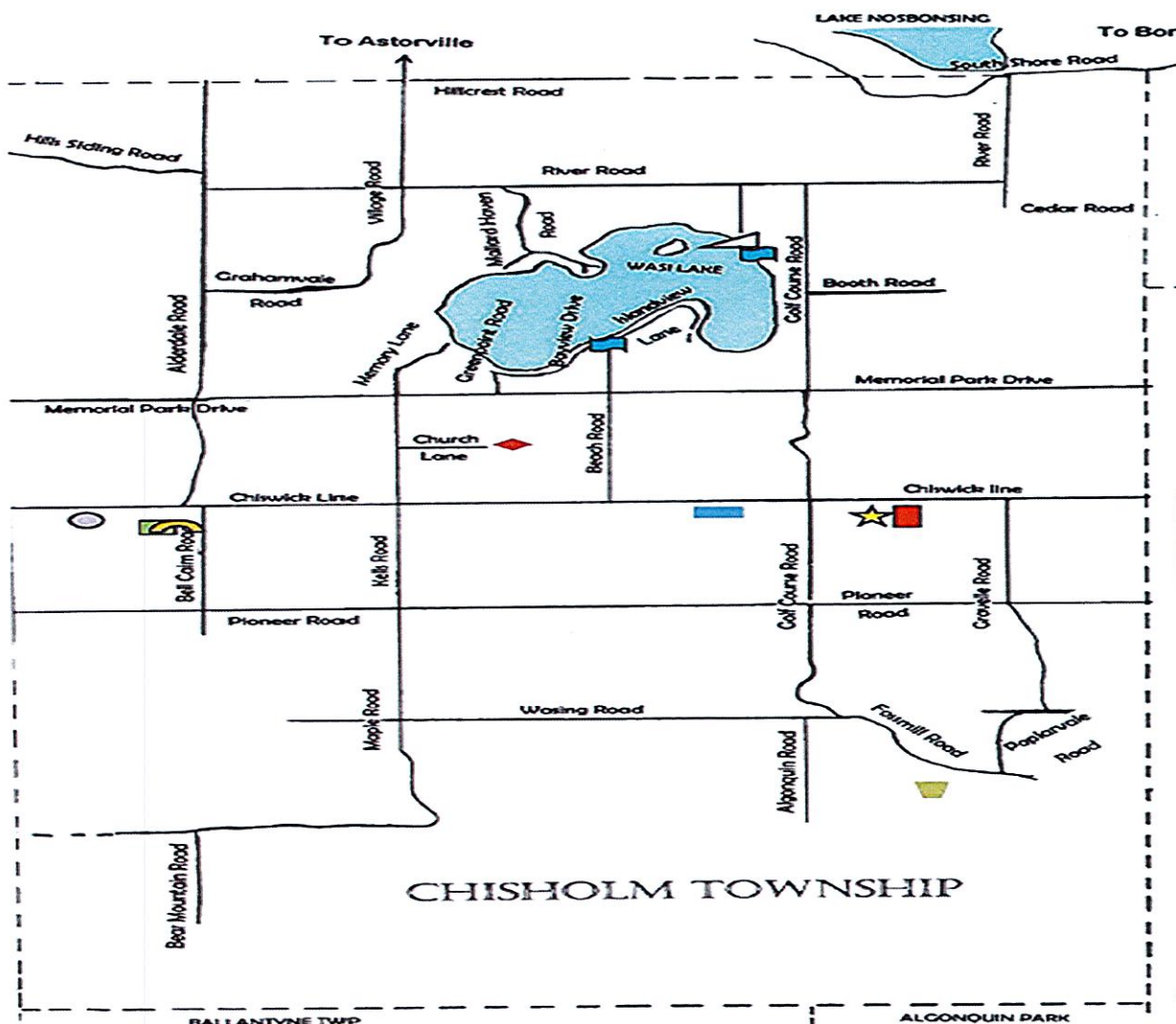
